

Bluffton University Commencement Parking May 4, 2024

Welcome to the Bluffton University campus! We hope this map helps provide details on where to park for the Commencement ceremony.

Out of courtesy for our village residents, please do not park along Elm St., Spring St., Bentley Rd. or Augsburgur Rd. Parking is also not allowed on grassy areas on university property.

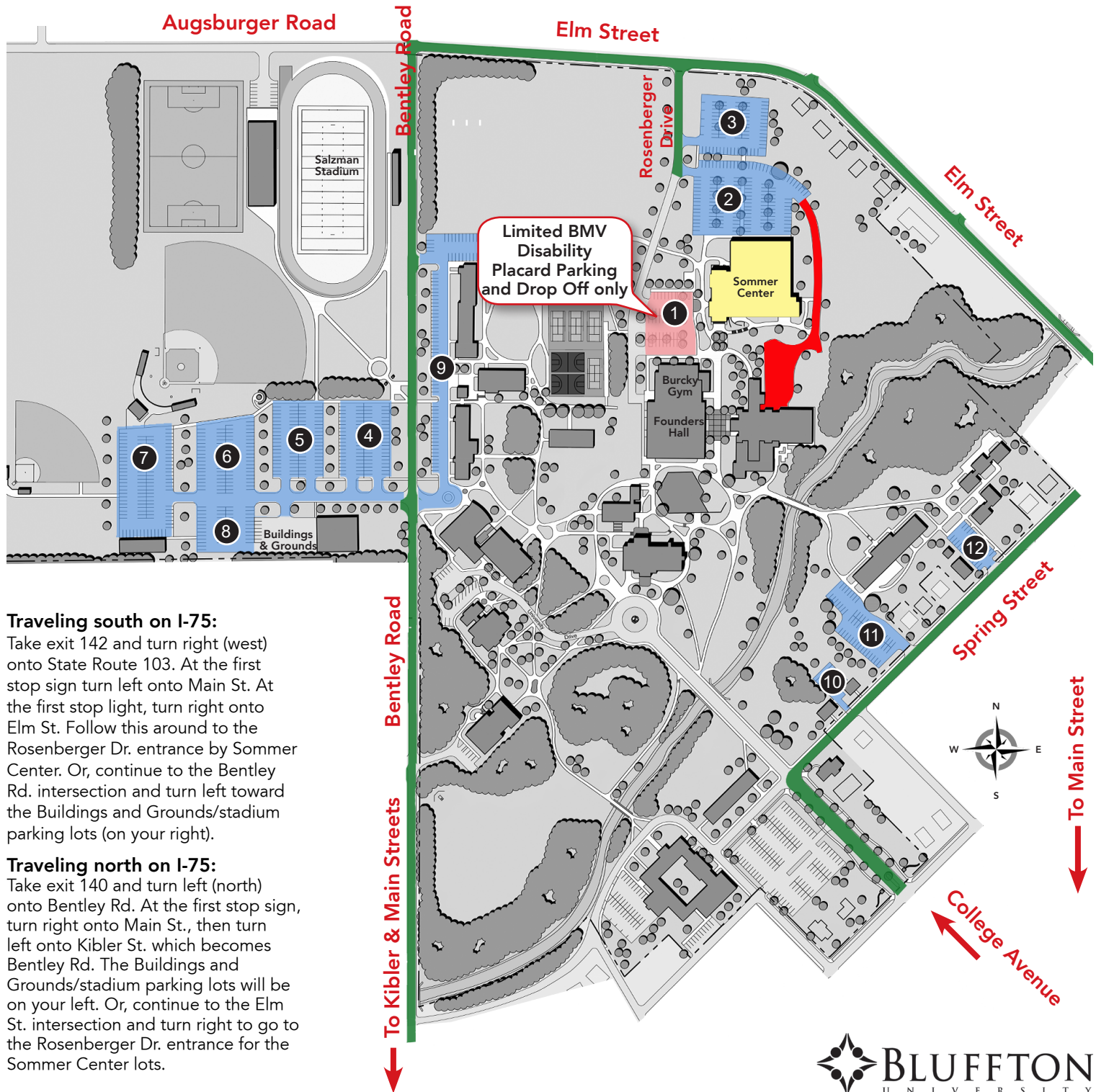
All parking is first-come, first-served, including accessibility parking (#1) directly in front of Sommer Center.

The green route on the map shows our suggested driving paths to get to the parking lots.

Parking is available in the following locations as marked on the map:

- **Accessibility permit parking (#1 on map)**, is first-come, first-served, for those who have disability placards from the BMV. It is available for **anyone** to drive up and drop off family members who may not be able to walk from the other lots.
- Sommer Center lots off Elm St. and Rosenberger Dr. (**#2 and #3**)
- Buildings and Grounds/stadium lots off Bentley Rd. (**#4-8**)
- Residential lots (**#9**)
- Three lots off of Spring St. (**#10-12**)

The lower lot behind Sommer Center is reserved for emergency vehicles only.



Traveling south on I-75:

Take exit 142 and turn right (west) onto State Route 103. At the first stop sign turn left onto Main St. At the first stop light, turn right onto Elm St. Follow this around to the Rosenberger Dr. entrance by Sommer Center. Or, continue to the Bentley Rd. intersection and turn left toward the Buildings and Grounds/stadium parking lots (on your right).

Traveling north on I-75:

Take exit 140 and turn left (north) onto Bentley Rd. At the first stop sign, turn right onto Main St., then turn left onto Kibler St. which becomes Bentley Rd. The Buildings and Grounds/stadium parking lots will be on your left. Or, continue to the Elm St. intersection and turn right to go to the Rosenberger Dr. entrance for the Sommer Center lots.
